Mustang of the Month

Tim's and Nikki's 1995 Ford Mustang GT Coupe

My families current project is a 1995 ford mustang gt coupe. Bought the vehicle last year In Marysville Washington. Located it on the internet, and my wife and I drove up to see it. After looking at it, I said lets skip on it and my wife said, "it had potential." We made an offer, and the old girl is ours now. First of this year 2010, We replaced the engine with a reman. from Ford Motor Company. It was cost effective than to rebuild the old motor. At the same time, the transmission was rebuilt as well. The whole front suspension was replaced or rebuilt with all new parts. The engine has a BBK cold air induction, BBK headers, BBK adjustable fuel presure regulator, BBK 76 mm mass air meter calibrated to 30lb. Ford fuel injectors. Exhaust has a Magnaflow x-pipe with high flow cats on it. We are running with a Diablo custom tune by John at Horse Power Ranch. Now, Nov.2010, we have now added a Edelbrock performer upper/lower intake as well as a Edelbrock 70mm throttlebody. Now, for an early Christmas and Birthday present, my wife bought me a Ford Racing aliminum drive shaft and a Borla exhaust system. The last thing we did to the mustang was have the rear end re-built. It was rebuilt in early Nov. 2010. Our stock gears were 2.73 and replaced them with Ford Racing 3.55 gears. We went from a 28 spline axle to a 31 spline axle. The axles are from Moser, the differential is an Eaton, replaced all bearings and seals. Had the axle power coated black. We replaced the rear upper and lower control arms with BBK control arms. The rear springs were repainted black with new red spring isolators from Enegy Suspension. Also, had replaced rear brake calipers, brake pads with Hawk performance street pads, and rear brake rotors with Brembo cross driilled rotors. Future plans for this car is to have the interior replaced and the car to be repainted with the same color. The vehicle has had all of the work done by ABC Transmision in Tacoma Washington. The tuning has been done by John at Horse Power Ranch in Maple Valley Washington. If it has not been for these 2 places working on this mustang, it would have been a very much longer road for my family and I. We appricate all the hard work to the ones who has helped make our project what it is today.

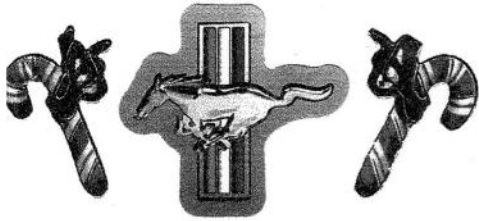

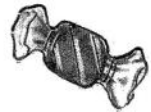

I just want to let everyone know that I was able to purchase the cool little suction cups I used last year at Lowes and have about 5 or 6 boxes of 25 for \$2 a box. If you want to go to Lowes and get your own this style has a slot to accept the cord and light and doesn't have any metal hooks. They also have abundant supplies of LED lights in assorted strings of 50 & 100 lights in colors or all white. Remember to power these you will need an AC inverter to plug into your car's lighter or AC adapter outlet. I found mine at Fred Meyer and is adequate for the lights.
