# Shepherd's Pie OAMC

### Ingredients

- o 2 lbs ground beef
- o 1 small onions, peeled and chopped
- o 2 (10 1/4 ounce) cans beef gravy
- o 2 cups frozen corn
- o 1 1/2 cups frozen peas
- o 1 cup carrots, peeled and diced

#### For each casserole

- o 2 -3 cups mashed potatoes
- o 2 tablespoons butter, melted
- o Paprika



### Directions

In a Dutch oven or stockpot, cook the beef over medium heat.

About halfway through add the onion.

Cook until the beef is no longer pink, drain off the grease.

Microwave the carrots for 2 minutes.

Add the gravy and veggies.

Cool and put into 2 freezer containers. I put them in [freezer bags](#).

To prepare: Thaw frozen beef mixture in the [refrigerator](#).

Put into a greased 2 quart [baking](#) dish.

Top with mashed potatoes, melted butter and sprinkle with paprika.

Bake uncovered at 350F for 30-35 minutes or until heated through.

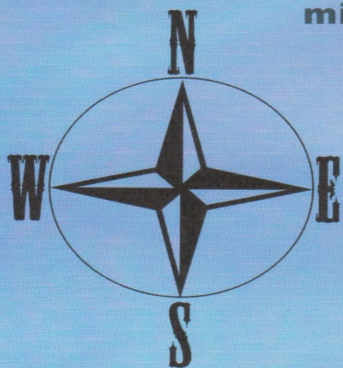

## Pierce County Mustang Club Scavenger Hunt Rules

Our April cruise will be a scavenger hunt. It will be an individual hunt.  
Depending on how this one goes, we might consider doing a team hunt later this year.  
The hunt will consist of 3 parts.

1. There is a list of 40 photographs that can be taken.
2. There are 40 items to be found.
3. There are 11 questions to be answered.

The photographs, items and questions have different point values, depending on their level of difficulty.

Remember, you will not be able to take all photographs, find all items, or answer all questions.  
There is a time restraint. 1:30PM

A digital camera is preferred, but we can work with a cell phone also.

We will have 3 trophies and 3 plaques to award to the 6 people with the highest point count.  
The first 25 people will receive a dash plaque, along with 2 surprise items and everyone will receive directions and instructions.

We will leave Applebee's @ the S. Hill Mall at 10 AM on April 20<sup>th</sup>. The route will take us to Shaw Road, Orting Hwy, Rhodes Rd to Bonney Lake . Continuing to the Safeway on 410 ( Stop ). From there we will drive along Lake Tapps to Lakeland Towne Ctr. ( Stop ) Onto Pacific and a short ride on Hwy 167. Pass Smith Brothers Dairy to Redondo Beach, into Northeast Tacoma, down into the Tide Flats continuing to Fife. It was a stunning cruise in the winter. It should be breathtaking in the spring. (For a while NE Tacoma was on my route while I was still working. I always enjoyed the drive down Marine View Drive into the Tide Flats. Sunshine, trees and flowers in bloom and Santana playing, FANTASTIC).
