Recipe Corner: Apple Chicken Curry

Ingredients

Makes: 4 Servings

- 4 boneless chicken breasts
- _ 1½ teaspoon nsa curry powder, divided
- _ 1/4 teaspoon Mrs. Dash
- _ 1 tablespoon or more nsa chicken broth as needed to prevent sticking
- _ 1 large Golden Delicious apple, peeled, chopped (or use 1 or 2 small Galas)
- _ 1/3 cup chopped onion



Preparation method

With meat mallet or similar utensil, pound chicken to ¼ inch thickness; sprinkle or rub chicken with half of curry powder and Mrs. Dash. In heated nonstick skillet with broth, add chicken and cook, turning, 8-10 minutes or until chicken is brown and tender (cooking time depends upon level of burner). Remove chicken to platter, keep warm. To same skillet, add apples and onions (may need to add little more broth); sprinkle with remaining curry powder and cook, stirring 2-3 minutes or until apple and onion are almost tender. Spoon over chicken. Serve with rice, if desired.


