#### Recipe Corner: Pumpkin Dump Cake

#### **Ingredients**

- 1 (29 ounce) can pumpkin puree 3eggs
- 1/2 cup packed brown sugar
- 1/2 cup white sugar
- 1 (12 fluid ounce) can evaporated milk
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1/4 teaspoon ground cloves
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 (18.25 ounce) package spice cake mix
- 1/2 cup coarsely chopped pecans
- 1/2 cup melted butter



#### **Directions**

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Grease a 9x13 inch pan.
- 2. In a large bowl, combine pumpkin puree, eggs, brown sugar, white sugar and milk. Stir in <u>cinnamon</u>, ginger, cloves and salt. Pour into pan. Sprinkle dry cake mix evenly over the pumpkin filling. Sprinkle pecans over the cake mix. Drizzle melted butter over all.
- 3. Bake in the preheated oven for 50 to 60 minutes, or until the edges are lightly browned. Allow to cool
