Recipe Corner: Pineapple Upside-down Biscuits

Ingredients

- 1 (10-ounce) Can Crushed Pineapple
- 1/2 cup Packed light brown sugar
- 1/4 cup (1/2 stick) butter, at room temperature
- 10 Maraschino cherries
- 1 package refrigerated buttermilk biscuits (10 count)

.



Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees F.
- 2. Grease 10 cups of a muffin tin
- 3. Strain the can of pineapples, save the juice for later
- 4. Combine the pineapple, brown sugar, and butter, mix well
- 5. Divide the pineapple mixture among the muffin cups
- 6. Place cherry in the middle of each muffin cup ensuring it cherry hits bottom of cup
- 7. Place 1 biscuit in each cup on top of sugar and pineapple mixture
- 8. Spoon 1 teaspoon reserved pineapple juice over each biscuit
- 9. Bake for 12 to 15 min, or until golden brown
- 10. Cool for 2 minutes, invert the pan onto a plate to release the biscuits.
- 11. Serve Warm.


