It all started when I was 9. My mom and dad brought home a nearly new 1979 Mustang Coupe 5.0 in the spring of 1980. Over my growing years, we drove everywhere in that car. I can't even count how many times I got to wash the car. Let's say my mom never had to worry about having a clean car. After drivers education, I got to take my driving test in it. Then, as a senior in high school, I was able to drive it to school everyday. We sold the '79 in 1992, against my will. But when you're still living under your parents' roof you must follow their orders.

In 1994 I bought a 1986 GT. From there it has just gone down hill and several Mustang's later...



I met my partner in crime in 1996. With two car people in the house, it is a powerful combina-

tion. I followed his love for Volvo's and he followed my passion for Fords and Mustangs. At times we would have matching Volvo's, or matching Oldsmobile's, and of course a few times over the years matching Mustangs.



The most highly collectable Mustangs, that I have always wanted to own, are the 1993 Cobra (which one day I will have) and the SSP Mustang (retired police car). I am now on number 4 of the SSP Mustangs and will never sell the current one, a 1988 Pierce County Sheriff with 54k original miles. I have restored three others. Combined we both have owned at least 8 and currently have 3 SSPs.

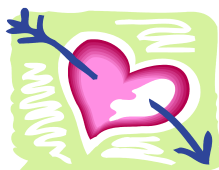

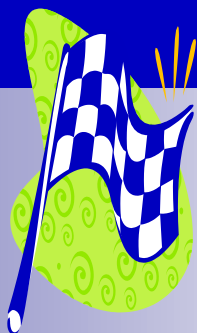
