We got our first '07 in 2007 while returning home from dropping off our son at college for the first time. He went to school in Oregon and Heidi sobbed all the way home. When we hit about Tacoma, Paul having had just about enough of it and wanting to be a good hubby, turned to Heidi and said quietly, "Do you want to go look at cars?" She momentarily stopped and said, "Yes."

We pulled into the dealership and test drove a convertible but neither of us could see out of it. They just happened to have a Blue Coupe. We moved our luggage from the SUV to the "Stang" and went home.

After a few years of using it as a daily driver, Heidi was smashed between 2 trucks on the freeway totaling the car but not her. They decided to get a bigger car.

While at one of many car shows, someone handed Paul a flyer for the Woodburn 50th Anniversary Mustang and Ford Parade. He immediately wanted to be part of it. But wait "Honey, we don't have a Mustang."

And so began Paul's search. In 2013, he found a used '07 at a local Honda dealer. We went to look at it, did a little negotiating and eventually brought home the car with the dealer adding the grey striping. (We actually were deciding between 2 but this one went "vroom, vroom" louder.)


Ponies and Pizza

Board meeting.




