

"When replacing fuses, Ford says to disconnect the negative cable of the battery before starting work. Depending on the year of your Mustang the fuse box location will be different, on older models look for the fuse box to be located under the dash by the drivers kick panel. Newer model Mustangs the fuse box is easier to get to, generally you will find it located under the hood next to a fender, look for a rectangular box and remove the lid to access the fuses."

"As we are moving out of the winter months it is time to bring the Mustangs out of storage, don't forget to check your battery health."






Well, we were sure sorry to have to missed this one but it looks like it was the usual great food and great fun.




