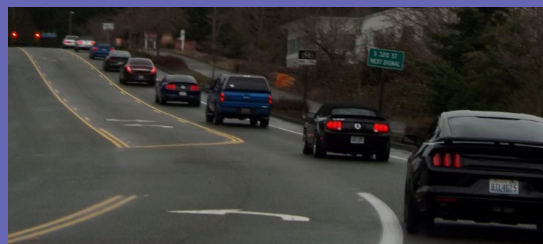

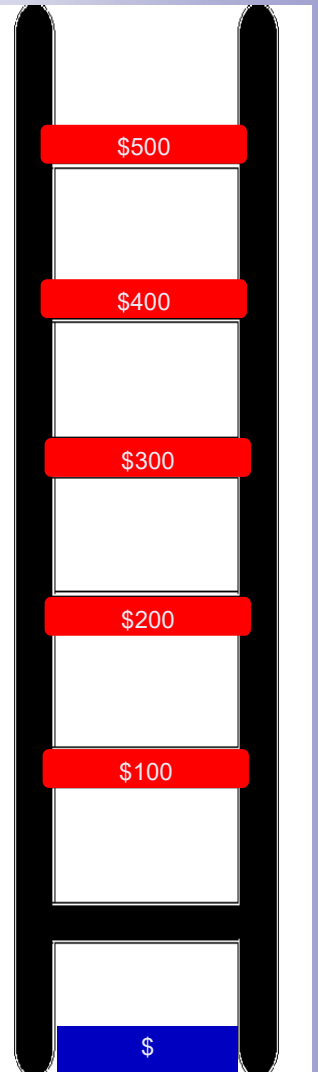

Information Article: Question for You

Car shows are coming but not quite here. Parades are a few months away. Cruises have already started for many. **Is it time to get your car out of the garage and into driving shape?** Oh I know, many of us drive them all year but even if we do, is this the time to check all the fluids, tires, and other technical and mechanical parts to make sure all is running well?

So I am not a mechanic. I have changed a tire and the oil and filled the tank with gas. (I don't care what my husband says, I have.) My biggest concern when I get into the car is: can I keep him from rolling down the window, does the heater work, and where is the blanket.

What is it that needs to be done to prepare for all the fun events our club and others do? According to yourmechanic.com you should air out the car and check under the hood for foreign objects (such as rodents, eggs, etc.) I am glad we drive ours!!!!

Aboutmustangs.com has several recommendations if you haven't driven in the past few months:

1. Change the oil and check fluids
2. Dispose of old gas (and I am assuming refill)
3. Check the battery (and if it has been on a tender, unplug it unless you have a super long extension cord.)

4. Check the tires, hoses, belts, plugs, brakes, and lights
