



Just in about Scott & Jody Wickett's 1967 Mustang convertible - We bought this car over 20 years ago (where does time go?) and it is always a work in progress. Upgrades over the years include front power disc brakes, limited slip 9" rear, Borgeson integral power steering, and 4 speed AOD transmission. When upgrading the transmission (after the original C-4 went out) we discovered the engine is not original (it has the original 289 heads but the block is an early 70's 302). The engine is tired so we cur-

rently have a late 80's roller cam short block being built.

# In the News and Other Information

Trying to keep up with Mustang news? Here are a few items to check out.

### In the July Mustang Times:

Wow, was it packed this month. Here are a few of the tidbits I took away from the issue.

- It is the 50th Anniversary of the Cobra Jet, the 1968 Mustang Fastback Drag Car. Sixty-eight are being built to celebrate. According to *Mustang Times*, they have a supercharged 5.2 liter Coyote V8, NHRA certified roll cage, drag race specific additions, and specially designed weld racing wheels with a 50th anniversary badge. They will be rolled our on August 23rd-26th at the Cobra Jet 50th Anniversary Reunion in Norwalk, Ohio. That ought to be a site to see.
- The 2018 Mustang was the best selling sports coupe in the world for the 3rd year in a row.
   "Global registrations in 2017 totaled 125, 809 cars." According to the article over 1/3rd were outside the US. That means about 81,866 in the

US. I wonder if they will all come to our show???

- Another anniversary! What car appeared 50 years ago and was a single car build for a tire test? You got it, the Shelby American, 427, Shelby GT500 Super Snake. In 1978 only one of these was built by Shelby American for the purpose of testing the Goodyear high-speed tire. Well, according to the *Times*, there will be 10 more built from donor Mustang fastbacks. The will have 550hp 427s from Shelby and Shelby serial numbers. Starting price ——\$249,995. Not bad (if you can do it) as the original sold at auction in 2013 for \$1.3 million.
- And...if that isn't enough anniversaries....40th for the 1978 King Cobra. You know the one.
   Based on the Mustang II with the snake on the hood and the 302 under it.
