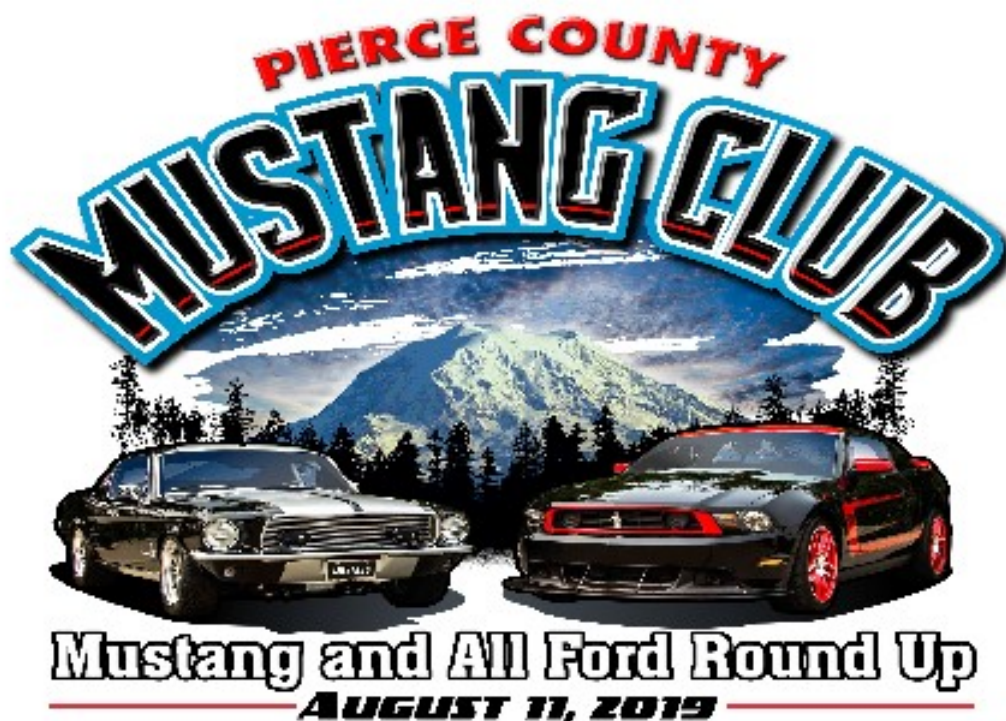

On July 2, 2019 **Lee Iaccoca** passed away in Los Angeles. It was Iaccoca who, according to an article in a CJ Pony Parts Newsletter, "stumbled upon a sketch by ...Gale Halderman" that began the "design for Ford Mustang." He and "Henry Ford, officially introduced the first Mustang at the New York World's Fair on April 17, 1964." I believe I can speak for all of us, THANK YOU Mr. Iaccoca for the part you played in bringing this car to all of us.

Trying to keep up with the Mustang news? Here are a few items to check out.

From the **Mustang Times**, July 2019:

- Our club has been discussing ways to get more youth involved with the car hobby and hopefully with our club. We are clearly not the only ones discussing that topic. In this issue of MCA's **Mustang Times** there was an article from the Northeast Georgia Mustang Club about their Youth Mentoring Program. Their story is very interesting and well worth reading. The program "stems around an invitation, a connection, and knowledge sharing." It says that "once we got them to show up, we found that making them part of what we were doing was the key to success. Plug them in and expect them to volunteer, teach them about the Mustang and its history and show them how to work on and maintain their Mustangs." Teach "them about club membership and their value in the club...Give them a role in the management of the youth program." Older members teach younger members and they get a sponsored MCA membership with the perks of getting information and eligibility to enter MCA shows.

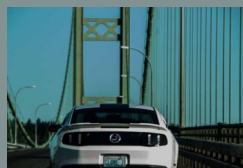
Being at a car show is like being at a family reunion.
