2019 CHARITY DISTRIBUTION REPORT

PCMC members-you continue to be a blessing in our communities.

<u>SANTA'S CASTLE (JBLM)</u> \$300 annual donation plus \$257 from year-long miscellaneous donations and show participation awards. Our annual toy drive delivered boxes and boxes of toys with an estimated value of \$450.

EMERGENCY FOOD NETWORK Our \$1,500 cash donation will provide 7,500 meals for families in need. Volunteers also donated 72 hours repackaging 13,200 pound of miscellaneous household items and 6,600 pounds of clam chowder. Volunteer time value \$1,080.

ST. FRANCIS HOUSE Our \$1,500 gift will be used by Sister Pat's emergency needs. St. Francis House was also the beneficiary of the 50/50 raffle at our annual car show receiving \$367 plus many direct cash donations by attendees.

CARING FOR KIDS In addition to the year end \$600 donation, members and car show guests donated 44 backpacks stuffed with school supplies for an estimated total value of \$1,540 plus cash donations of \$265.

SPANAWAY FOOD BANK \$600 has been donated to help with the rebuilding of their fire destroyed food bank. They provide a much needed service to the families in the Spanaway area.

THE TEARS FOUNDATION The Foundation provides emotional and financial support to families experiencing the death of their child. Our \$500 gift will help them begin the path to healing.

PUGET SOUND PET FOOD BANK Received 78 pounds of dog/cat food and 68 pounds of cat litter. Estimated value \$108.60

KORUM/FORD PEANUT BUTTER DRIVE Collected 493 pounds, value \$1,150.

TOTAL VALUE CASH/PRODUCT/VOLUNTEER TIME \$10,177.60




