How to add your voice to the Newsletter and get involved!

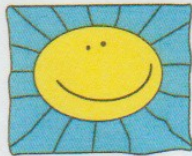
Lets work together to add something new and re-energize this Newsletter. Do you have a topic that you are passionate about/interested in or simply have some experience with?

However you do it, get your voice and experiences out there and lets make this a great Newsletter!

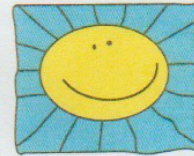

Dear Friends,

Thank you so much for your generous donation of \$500 to Caring for Kids. Although everything has been unpredictable, we have managed to continue our daily work. I think this time of year it is even more important to love and support our kids and families in need.

Our Holiday Fair on December 5th was a big success helping 1,851 kids with gifts, plus a ham for the family. We knew we would have a struggle getting enough volunteers, but we had some hard working volunteers thanks especially to Clover Park Kiwanis, Lake Louise Staff and of course our dedicated Caring for Kids Team. We were able to get everything out on time when the schools arrived for pickup.

Since the Holiday Fair we have been working on distributing gifts to 61 more kids. It will be like this until Christmas Eve day as more desperate families contact their schools for help. So far we have also given out 835 color books and crayons sets to food banks and community organizations to be handed out to their families.

Our Clothing Bank has been supplying the regular clothing bank orders but there has been an increase of orders for coats and shoes. On Thursday we received orders for 22 pairs of shoes from Clover Park High School for their students and their brothers and sisters.

We struggle every day to keep our shelves full to meet the needs of our kids and families. Food, clothing, school supplies and hygiene products continue to be distributed to our community.

I am Michael Dawn Peters, the owner of the Mustang of the Month. Thank you !!!

I was emailed by Jerry Murphy to confirm that my little blue Mustang had been chosen "Mustang of the Month". Actually my neighbor, Scott Wickett's Mother-in-law, shared this news with me! I am so surprised!!

My husband Ben and I have been members of the Mustang Club for a REALLY LONG time. My blue '65 in-line, 200 cubic inch, six cylinder Filly has been a daily driver since I bought it - with the generous help of my parents - in the spring of 1967 after my graduation from WSU. It was my daily transportation from Olympia to Tacoma where I worked at the Bon Marche'. Years later, through marriage and children, the Mustang took us on trips, to school, roller skating, soccer, track and eventually became the daily drive of our son, Michael, and then our daughter, Janna, while they were in high school. In fact, Janna and the car were featured in July 1992 newsletter as the Car of the Month when Janna won the High School class in the Lakefair Mustang and Classic Car Show in Olympia.

We spent many years enjoying the PCMC poker runs through Pierce County's back country and the spaghetti dinner meetings at the Pierce County Fair Grounds.

About 10 years ago, the Mustang couldn't make it out of the garage. We trans-

ported the car via flatbed car carrier to the Mustang Ranch for an overhaul and power brakes. Since then, it has remained garaged and is driven through our South Hill neighborhood when weather permits - which is not often enough!!.

My hope is that our grandsons will enjoy driving and working on this car - if they demonstrate the "proper respect" for the car. The oldest grandson is nearly 15, so that may happen sooner than later. If so, there may be a whole new generation of Peters in the Pierce County Mustang Family.
