
Emergency food and clothing bank orders were in high demand the last week of school. Open door picked up 50 emergency food bags in one day.

### **PCMC General Club Meeting Minutes for January 18, 2022**

**6:00 Call to Order**

#### Welcome & Introductions/Sandy

Sandy welcomed everyone and noted the order of business had been rearranged somewhat from previous agendas. She also noted the club will celebrate its 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary in March and deserved congratulations for its excellence and longevity.

#### Announcements & Acknowledgments/Sandy

Sandy congratulated the January Mustang of the Month owners Jack and Joi Curtis, whose names were drawn at the November meeting. Sandy acknowledged the help she had received in her efforts so far as the new club president and thanked everyone.

#### **Old Business**

#### Previous month's General meeting Minutes /Sandy

Sandy noted as there was no general meeting in December, there were no minutes to approve.

#### Charity Check Delivery/Heidi

Heidi reported that she and Jerry and Kathy Murphy met at St. Francis House to deliver the check. They were joined by Monika Kirkland for the second stop at EFN. They proceeded to Carr's Restaurant where they met Diane from Caring For Kids. All three groups expressed their thanks for the donations.

#### Jackets/Vests Orders /Nancy

Nancy reported that enough orders have been received to qualify for the reduced pricing from the printer. She will meet with the printer this Thursday to review colors and printing plans. She said the order might be prepared in time for delivery at next month's meeting.

#### January Party/Missy & Karen

Karen reported that approximately 30 people had RSVP'd for the party. She said the planning and preparations were going well. She noted a headcount needed to be provided to the restaurant by this Saturday. Nancy said she would send an

email reminder to the membership about RSVPs.

#### **New Business**

#### February General Meeting-Agenda topics/matters of interest/Sandy

Sandy asked that if anyone had any topics/business/questions for the February meeting to please let her know.

#### January 2022 Treasurer's Report/Nancy

Nancy provided copies of the current financial statement. She noted FY 2022 began with a bank balance of \$10,198.74. The balance for today's meeting date is \$13,620.62. She said the balances include car sponsorship funds for the car show in the amount of \$2,950. Current report includes dues received, and pass-through expenses for the upcoming baseball game event. The membership had no questions or concerns; Heidi moved to accept the report and Jerry seconded the motion. Motion carried.

#### FY 2022 Club Budget/Nancy

Nancy presented the proposed budget for 2022 that the board had prepared. She explained many details of the car show budget and the administrative budget. She stressed the importance of finding sponsors for the car show in order to meet the funding goals for the year. She briefly discussed major administrative expenses such as the various insurances the club carries and the rent for the storage unit for the club show supplies. She emphasized that the budget currently does not have an amount for charitable giving for this year as it is necessary to wait until after the car show to know exactly where the funding will stand. There were no questions or concerns from the membership. Laurie noted that Nancy does such an excellent job of preparing the reports and explaining them that it is no surprise that there are no questions or concerns. Nancy said she hoped every member of the club knows they are welcome to review the financial statements and the accounts at any time. Paul made a motion to accept the budget as presented; the motion was seconded by Rick Coombs. Motion carried.

She said the Nordlunds have always been helpful especially with the car shows, raffles and picnics. She said Pam and Wayne have been very helpful with the car show registrations and sponsorships, and Pam has served as secretary and in other roles.

#### Car Show Planning Report/Missy and Monika

Missy said planning is going well. She is working with Custom Apparel on the design for the tee shirt for this year. She said the design will change somewhat from previous years in order to acknowledge the 30<sup>th</sup> club anniversary. She said the car show planning meetings are the second Tuesday of the month and that help is still needed. Monika noted several positions were open including Registrations, Pre-registrations, Rentals, Raffle, and Volunteer Coordinator. Pam volunteered to take care of Pre-registrations and Fran volunteered to be the Volunteer Coordinator. Missy and Burt noted they are working on sorting out the various classes for the show. Sandy said she has begun her work as Sponsorship Chair. Monika noted the Trivia Chair is open too but Missy said the Trivia may not happen this year. Discussions will continue about it at the next car show planning meeting.

### Upcoming Events/Activities/Various

Nancy reminded everyone that the January Brunch event is this Saturday. Monika confirmed the brunch

is at Elmer's Restaurant on Hosmer Street. Missy reminded that the party is next weekend and will include gifts and games. Karen noted again that the reservations are needed this week. Pam & Wayne Pistella have worked on the car show in Registrations and Sponsorships. Pam has also served the club in various leadership roles including club secretary.

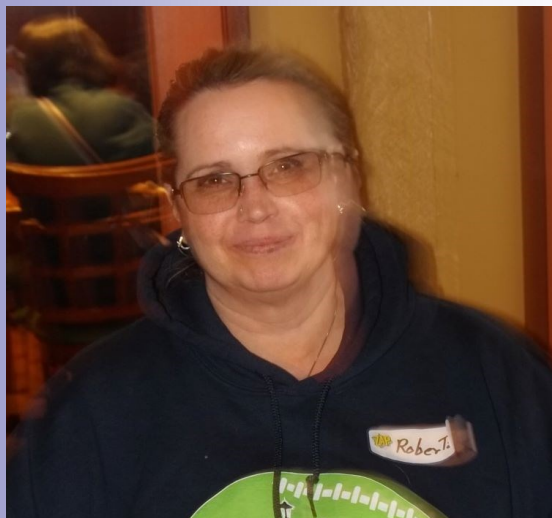
