My Mustang story and how it all started - Bryan Zimbelman

I have owned many Mustangs in my life! It started in high school when I owned a '74 hatchback, which was fun while it lasted. In college, I bought a Black 85 GT hatchback with sun roof, which was an absolute blast to drive for many years until kids came along, then it became very impractical. Then for my 30th birthday we bought a '67 coupe that needed a lot of attention, fast forward 7 years later I finally got it on the road. We had fun with that car for 15 years; during this time we also purchased a new 2007 vista blue V6, which was a daily driver for about 5 years.

In 2008, I was on a business trip in Detroit and was lucky enough to get a VIP tour of the Saleen plant, where I was able to see and sit in the making of the 25th anniversary specials of which only 25 were to be made. I was also lucky enough to see the Dan Gurney tribute Saleens (of which they were supposed to make 100 white, 100 red, and 100 blue but only ended up making 67 total, I think).

That is when I became hooked on owning a Saleen for myself. That began my search of a new edge style Saleen. I happened to find one in OHIO for sale and messaged the seller with an offer and to my surprise he accepted my offer. I bought this sight unseen and after several emails back and forth we got the deal wrapped up and shipped it out west. This car has been so much fun to drive and attend car shows in, as far away as Calgary and Banff Canada, with stops in Mt. Rushmore, SD and Devils Tower, WY.


