



# Terry & Deborah Howells 1966 Red Mustang Convertible

PCMC Car of the month! Oh boy that's great! Oh wait now I have to put pen to paper and write about it.

So here goes some info on this month's PCMC Mustang, a 1966 convertible!

I remember back my first car ever purchased, a 1957 Chevrolet two door hardtop, that I excitedly traded for my second, a 1965 Mustang coup 289 four speed which I enjoyed throughout my collage and youthful years. Driving my 65 many memorable miles with various friends from Canada to Mexico and most all western US cities and states as well. It served all my needs and I'm sure exceeded them.



However as it is with most cars as years pass they are traded for newer models and on we go. I know we all can look back through the years and say what was I thinking, man I would love to have that car back! Well such was the case with me and my longing for my old 65, personally speaking the classic lines of the first gen Mustangs 64 ½ thru 66 have always been my favorites with fastbacks, convertibles, and coups in that order.



With great excitement we purchased our 1966 convertible nearly eight years ago, unfortunately I do not have a great amount of knowledge of its past history other than a folder that contained a fair amount of maintenance and repair receipts, which seem to indicate it has been well taken care of. Some of these which showed the installation of a new soft top recently installed, as well as new carpet. It does have all original door trim, seats and all interior trim which all is in pristine condition.

Some of the creature comforts it came with are power steering and power brakes, 289 four barrel carb and automatic transmission. Upgrades we have added to it for safety as well as comfort reasons are front disc brakes and dual master cylinder, factory air conditioning, bluetooth am/fm stereo system and led dash lighting for enhanced visibility during night time driving.

We did just this past April have The Mustang Ranch rebuild the 289 engine with what Donny called a long block rebuild. Which as I understand is basically a new engine, so we decided as this was being built, we would have the auto

transmission rebuilt as well. So, the car because of the wet weather we have been having has been sitting in the garage with under 100 miles on new engine and tranny.

Well as I write this, she is put away in the stable awaiting sunny weather be once again saddled up and hitting the trail. Hopefully we will see many of you soon on one of those trails.
