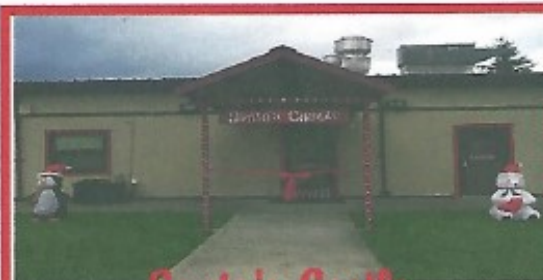


Honoring All Veterans of PCMC

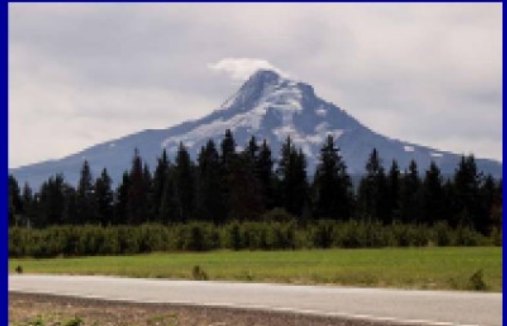

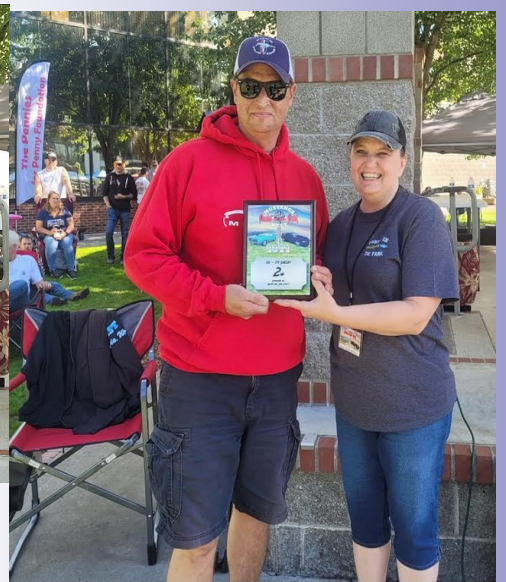
As we pulled into the show site we spied another 9 member cars. Total for the day... 25

It was a beautiful day for the show and once all 312 entries got parked fun was had by all along with a few members going home with awards and raffle prizes.

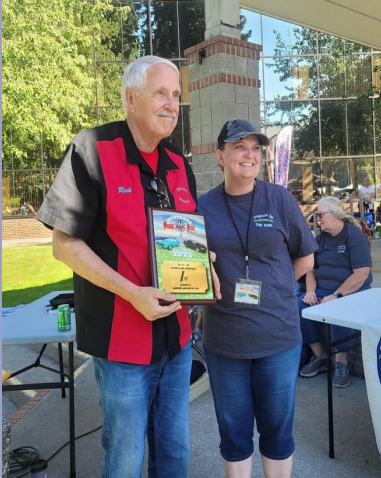

Dear Friends,

Thank you so much for your generous donation of 39 Backpacks and \$270 to Caring for Kids. Your love and support of our kids and families in need is so important. Together we are making a difference!

To be able to find all the supplies we needed on sale was overwhelming. We shopped in person and online about every day. One day at Walmart three of us shopped for nine carts of supplies. It took a half an hour to fill the carts and two and a half hours to check out. They no longer do quantities so we ended up with twenty-nine receipts. Online there is a maximum quantity you can order for each item, so we order the same thing for several days.

The Ready to Learn Fairs were a success. Our major event at Harrison Prep helped one thousand sixteen kids with a backpack, school supplies, hygiene products, new and good used clothing and a hot dog lunch. West Pierce gave out 200 bike helmets, but after running out we are ordering 400 for next year. The Clover Park Technical College and local businesses provided 157 free haircuts! The Health Department was able to give 34 vaccinations and Covid Shots. The events at Springbrook and Tillicum helped over 200 kids with backpacks, school supplies and hygiene products.

We are now getting ready to stuff and send backpacks to the schools for kids who need help. Early Learning has already ordered 40 filled backpacks and 45 emergency food kits. Harrison Prep has ordered 50 filled backpacks. Our work is never done!

Mustang of the Month

Lynette Gallant-Nee and Paul Nee

1965 Mustang Coupe

Congratulations Lynette Gallant-Nee and Paul Nee!

Net's '65 is Lynette Gallant-Nee's 1st car. Her parents purchased this early 1965 Mustang coupe for her in 1977. Lynette and most of her friends learned how to drive behind this Pony's steering wheel. When we ran the numbers and codes for the original build, this car came off the line at the San Jose, CA plant in September of 1964. It came with and still has the original Hi-Pro/K Code bottom end/block but just a 2 barrel carb and standard heads. Since then, it has gone through three reiterations to the present one which was begun in 2003 and completed in 2004. To date, we have added an Edelbrock Air Gap intake, Edelbrock 4 barrel carb, Hi-Pro 302 FI Heads, electronic ignition, MSD box, front disc brakes, and a couple other safety features and oodles of chrome. The color is Titanium Grey Metallic (a Mazda color) and sports Centerline wheels and BF Goodrich TA Radials.

This Pony has been a blast to drive and show off, now and then has even won a few awards and trophies from various shows it has been entered in. The 2 pictures are now and then shots; the one with Net standing next to it was taken on September 10th at the Rod Run to the End of the World car show on the Long Beach Peninsula where we also have our vacation place and the other was taken shortly after the build was finished in 2004 at the Fox Island Boat Launch at sunrise.

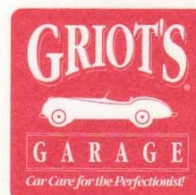
