Charity Involvement

2022 CHARITY GIVING REPORT

PCMC donated \$6,000.00 from funds raised at our annual car show. The total represents 66% of the net. These funds and others raised were distributed as follows.

Emergency Food Network – 1 in 9 individuals are food insecure in Pierce County.

Our \$2,000.00 donation equals 10,000 meals. PLUS our gift was matched on Giving Tuesday for another 10,000 meals! Additionally club members donated two Saturday mornings volunteering a part of EFN's Repack Program valued at \$1,125.00 in no paid labor.

One in nine individuals are food insecure in Pierce County.

Santa's Castle – We support our military families.

\$1,606.70 in cash plus \$150.00 in gift cards. The toy drive itself resulted in a tower of toys, games, dolls, trucks, books, stuffed animals, art supplies, batteries, makeup kits. Estimated value \$1,000.00. Additionally a club member volunteers her time as an Elf.

Caring for Kids – Helping kids in Lakewood, Steilacoom and University Place

\$1,000 in cash plus a donation of 500 pairs of socks valued at \$2,500.00. Participants at our August car show donated 39 backpacks stuffed with school supplies with an estimated value of \$1,635 plus cash donations of \$270.00.

St. Francis House – Offers hope and eases hardships to those in need in East Pierce County.

Our \$2,000.00 donation may help prevent an East Pierce County family from being one step away from homelessness, going without electricity or missing a job interview because they need a bus pass or other unforeseen emergency. The car show's 50/50 also raised an additional \$261.00.

Total value of cash, volunteer time and merchandize is \$13,547.70.


