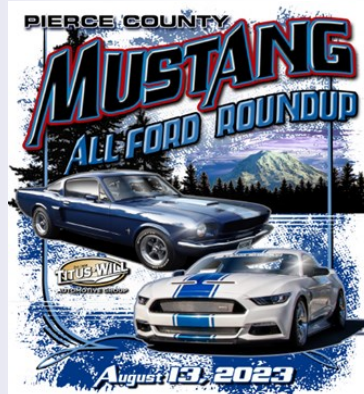
The club picnic is also coming up fast. Whether you come for the socializing, the food or the competition it's a fun time. Check out the flyer later in this edition of the Pony News.

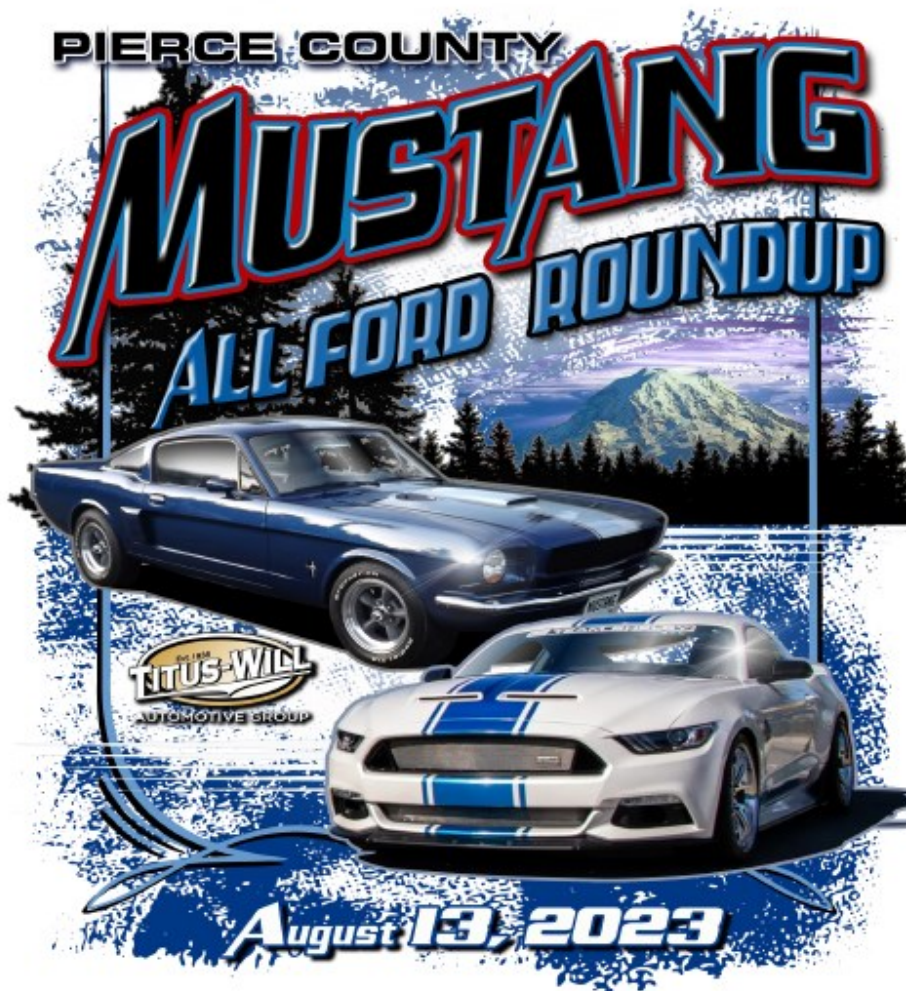

The X-Plan offers Mustang Club of America members the opportunity to purchase MOST new Ford vehicles at a substantial savings. Applying for your pin number is an easy and straight forward process. MCA DOES NOT send you your X-Plan pin number. You must apply for this yourself.

- You must be a Digital or a Standard MCA member.
- At the time of purchase you must be a MCA member for 90 days. This means if your account is inactive/expired for a couple of months and you renew your account, your 90 days begins on the date of renewal. You will not be able to use the X-Plan pricing to purchase the vehicle until your 90 days has been established.
- Confirm that your dealer participates in X-Plan pricing. If they do, then apply for the X-Plan PIN number. You can do this by logging into your MCA account at www.mustang.org OR go to www.fordpartner.com website direct and enter the MCA partner code MC405.
- To find the X-Plan link on the MCA website, log into your MCA account search under the Resources tab. Click on Member Services, then scroll down for the X-Plan link and follow the steps to the Ford partner website.
- Please note the MCA does not have anything to do with the Ford website or your pin number. This is between you and Ford.
- When you receive your pin number PRINT YOUR CONFIRMATION page. You will need to give this page to your dealer along with your current MCA member card. The name on the MCA card needs to match the name on your pin confirmation. If you are new to MCA or renewing you should have your membership card well within your first ninety days of membership.

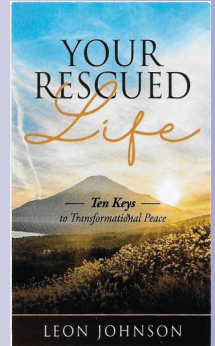
